

SUMMER CAMP LEADERS NEEDED FOR A UNIQUE, SUMMER CAMP IN HAMPSHIRE

WE ARE LOOKING FOR FUN, ENTHUSIASTIC CAMP LEADERS TO JOIN OUR AMAZING TEAM THIS SUMMER

If you are a fun, creative individual, with lots of energy and patience, and you'd like to be involved in a busy, fun team this summer, we want to hear from you!

We need a variety of full time and 'half' time camp leaders, who can teach the following areas:

- Performing arts/ drama
- Dance/ Singing/ Music
- Arts & Crafts
- Sports & Adventure
- Cooking (along with a further skill)
- TEFL/ TESOL English teachers or similar (this can be a **part time** or **full time** post)
- Supervision of camp catering (this can be a part time job)

This job can be residential or non-residential. We need at least 6 residential camp leaders for each camp, plus additional non-residential.

What are we looking for in you:

- English native speaker
- Ability to create lesson plans for and teach your area of expertise to groups of up to 15 girls aged 8-14
- Ability to multi-task
- Can do attitude
- Creativity, resilience, ENERGY AND FUN!!
- Ability to work long hours if required on some days

Dates/ availability:

• For both sessions, we need you to be available from night of Mon 19 June/ early morning Tues 18 June – late Friday 26 July (these dates including set



up, training and break down as well as various days off; actual camp runs from 24 June – 25 July, with a the weekend of 21 - 23 june off, plus further days off in middle)

• If you are applying for just one camp session, the dates would be per 2 week camp session, plus training/ clearing time.

We need our camp leaders to commit to at least the duration of <u>one</u> full camp session (2 weeks plus training/ clearing time), or ideally, both camp sessions, unless you are applying for a part time English teaching job or cooking supervision.

If a full time camp leader, depending on your main activity, you will be teaching approx 2 lessons every day, but will also take part in evening activities, sports & games, pastoral care and general camp life. You will have time off every day to relax and prepare classes too. If a part time camp leader, your hours will be dictated to according to what you are teaching.

We have a lot of resources to help you, and will give you quite a few ready prepared plans, but the aim is that your lessons can also be designed by you and meant to be informative, fun and creative lessons that the children look forward to, whether it is English class, or Cookery!

This is a hands-on job – **we all get our hands dirty**, in all senses of the word. But we promise, it is fun and our team is always GREAT! It is also one of the most rewarding jobs you may ever do, and something that will look extremely good on your CV for the future :)

Salary: Full time posts <u>start</u> from £1750 (plus £150 bonus for the most voted Camp Leader!), and can be up to £2100 according to age and experience, plus food and lodging (where relevant) – so you don't have to spend a penny while here; variable according to your days worked and experience.

You get time off each day, a weekend off before camp starts in June, 3 days off between camp sessions and time off per week. Bonus for returning Camp Leaders. If applying as an English teacher on a part time basis, please enquire.

Dates & Accommodation: Evening of Mon 19 June/ morning of 20 June (the first 4 days are relaxed training & set up) – Friday 26 July – the last days are clean up days). Only 4 weeks are 'actual' camp. You can choose to live at camp, lodging and food included, so you won't have to spend a penny – or if you prefer, you can return home if you are local.



We can accept applications for camp leaders who can ONLY do one camp session, ie, the 2 full weeks of camp plus training/ break down of camp, but we cannot accept applications from camp leaders for less time than this.

Camp is hard work, but a lot of fun!

We are a boutique, international summer camp for girls aged 8 – 14, located in the UK Hampshire countryside. Children from all over the world come for two week residential sessions to learn English and participate in a huge variety of great activities and life-skills, from sports, arts & crafts and music, to adventure & survival skills, drama and dance.
